



Here some important info for the two disciplines:

Accuracy Landing

1. The bulls-eye will be marked out at the Zulu Landing spot, where the tandems land.
2. We will have two official judges in reflector jackets measuring each landing.

Rules

Minimum of TWO Landings are required to become an accuracy landing contestant. The best of TWO landing measurements will be the final result for each contestant.

1st Prize

Open XC

1. This year we need all contestants to have a XContest account.
Registration is fairly easy via : <https://www.xcontest.org/world/en/>

For those who don't know, Xcontest is a global spanning platform to log and review your and flights of others. It also has a points/ranking calculation for each flight.

2. Please install the apps on your phone:
 - XCtrack (for Android) or
 - Flyskyhy (for Iphone)
 - Or other flight tracking app that creates IGC files.

Before Takeoff, make sure to switch on the tracking app, together with the GPS on your phone, so that it records your flight and creates an IGC file that can be uploaded to your account on Xcontest.

You can link Flyskyhy and XCtrack apps with Xcontest so your track will be uploaded automatically. (IGC files contain the plot of your entire flight that can be reviewed on Xcontest or other software)

Each flight will have a calculated amount of points. So the farther you fly the more points you get..
Flying triangles gets a you a bit more points..

Rules

Fly XC whenever you want. Whoever gets the highest points on Xcontest wins.
